- Create Public Awareness and build Dementia Friendly Communities through the Dementia Coalition Initiatives
- Offer Public Presentations for Education & Training
- Provide consults to Professionals regarding Dementia-related Issues, Improving Services or Care Planning
- Ensure ADRC Staff, County and Municipal Offices are Dementia-Capable Resources, that are Knowledgeable & Equipped with Appropriate, Competent & Sensitive Supports
